- Experience working with a team to achieve a common goal

- Must be an independent worker as the job may remain remote

Applicants must meet the following funding eligibility:

- Post-secondary graduate, up to 30 years, or younger, at the start of the internship;
- be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act for the duration of the employment
