

PHASE 1 USE OF PROCEEDS: \$10 MILLION

SUPPORT ECOSYSTEM - \$7M

- Full build-out of free, publicly accessible Student Energy entrepreneurship programs from concept through to global launch
- Scale-up of intake for existing programs
- Development of structures, systems, processes and accountability measures a.k.a. "building blocks of a healthy organization"

FUNDING FOR YOUTH PROJECTS - \$3M

- Capital directly invested in real world
- 500 funded ventures * \$6,000 average capital investment = \$3M
- Phase 1 Investments
 - 90% Guided Ventures (450 Ventures)
 - 10 Inspired Ventures (50 Ventures)
- Guided Ventures Streams
 - Molecules & Electrons
 - People & Systems





PROGRAMS OVERVIEW



Student Energy's events and Summits are broad in ambition and scope, ranging from the Student Energy Summit (SES) to the SevenGen Indigenous Youth Energy Summit, to marquee partnered events such as COP, the Clean Energy Ministerial, and Mission Innovation.

The SevenGen Council hosts the Indigenous Youth Energy Summit and ImaGeNation the Indigenous Youth Mentorship Program. Their work fosters Indigenous youth-led leadership on sustainable energy development.

ENERGY TRANSITION CAREERS TRAINING

Energy Transition Career Training (ETCT) is a four-month cohort-based intensive that gives students their first experience executing a real-world energy project in data, modeling, policy analysis or project development.

GLOBAL YOUTH FNFRGY OUTLOOK The Global Youth Energy Outlook (GYEO) is an entirely youth-led research project that aims to connect with 50,000 young people from around the world. It aims to answer the questions: (1) What actions do young people want to see happen to deliver a sustainable energy transition by 2030? (2) How do young people want to be part of energy solutions needed for this transition?

IMAGENATION

ImaGENation is an Indigenous Youth Mentorship Program in partnership with Indigenous Clean Energy, Student Energy, and SevenGen Student Council. The goal of the program is to provide an opportunity for Indigenous youth (ages 18-30) from across Canada to design, implement, learn about, and celebrate youth-led clean energy projects as it relates to land, food, water, and infrastructure sustainability within their community.



LEADERS FELLOWSHIP

Our Leaders Fellowship provides core energy systems education and guides young people through their first energy project. Delivered through a 10-month digital program including monthly mentorship, focused towards small teams building a community energy project.

PROGRAMS OVERVIEW



A Youth Advisory Council is a small representative group of youth with specific expertise, interests, and experiences, that work with an organization to advise on a specific issue or scope of work. At the end, advisors present the leadership of the organization with a set of recommendations and work hands-on with decision-makers to build a roadmap for implementing youth inputs.

Greenpreneurs is a cross-cutting virtual entrepreneurship incubator creating opportunity for youth to connect globally, facilitate knowledge sharing, and receive the support and idea validation to take their ideas from conversation to tangible impact.



The Energy System Map is a tool that makes the complex world of energy accessible. Combined with various Energy 101 videos on Student Energy's YouTube channel, these accessible digital energy education tools have received global attention from youth interested in learning about the energy systems.

Selected teams will undertake a 2-year project development training course designed for their chosen Guided Venture. Hosted on our web platform, training will include webinars, worksheets, and mentorship access. Successfully completing project deliverables will unlock higher levels of funding, ultimately leading to supplies procurement.
