

DATA AND IMPACT COORDINATOR

POSITION DESCRIPTION

Student Energy is a global charity building the next generation of energy leaders. We are a hard-working, fast paced team devoted to youth empowerment in the world of energy. Our team punches above its weight to develop innovative programs, meaningful international partnerships, and serve our community of young energy changemakers. Student Energy is looking to hire a fixed term, full-time (40 hours per week for 6 months) Data and Impact Coordinator to keep our organization-wide data and evaluation systems running smoothly. The Coordinator will be responsible for maintaining our Salesforce CRM database, advancing our data privacy and security initiatives, coordinating our evaluation activities, and assisting on other projects as needed. This is an exciting position for anyone who enjoys telling a story with data, seeing patterns in numbers, and creative problem-solving.

Reporting to the Director of Impact and Operations, the Coordinator will work with Student Energy in the following ways:

- Support the implementation and continued improvement of our Customer Relationship Management System (Salesforce) by analyzing team use, searching out new ways to save time, and acting as a team resource for all things Salesforce.
- Ongoing organization and management of Student Energy's professional, student, and organizational contacts using Salesforce, including data collecting, cleaning, entry, and lifecycle management.
- Maintain internal reporting dashboards and collaborate with other teams to produce timely and accurate external reporting.
- Research and help embed robust impact measurement and data collection techniques across organization
- Assist with the implementation of Student Energy's data vision, including initiatives related to data privacy and data security
- Develop and maintain resources for internal use and training on our core data tools, objectives, requirements
- Maintain documentation related to data management
- Coordinate our regular team-wide evaluation activities, and work in collaboration with our Partnership and Programs team to develop strong evaluation plans
- Complete or assist with data analysis as needed
- Other tasks as assigned.

REQUIREMENTS

The ideal candidate will possess the following qualities:

- Experience with and enthusiasm for working with data and CRMs, ideally Salesforce
- Experience with data analysis or data management
- Strong Excel skills
- Strong analytical skills
- Interest in youth, energy, and sustainable energy systems

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- Detail-oriented and highly organized
- Self-motivated and driven to produce quality results
- Must be an independent worker as the job will be remote
- Must be eager to learn new skills, and ready to take on whatever comes next

Applicants must meet the following funding eligibility:

- Be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment
- Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act for the duration of the employment
- Be legally able to work in Canada according to relevant laws and regulations of the province of territory of residence
- Not currently enrolled as a full-time student in a post-secondary institution
- Currently unemployed or underemployed

COMPENSATION AND TERM The Coordinator will receive \$40,000-45,000 annual equivalent salary, commensurate with experience, and work full-time up to 40 hours per week. The contract term is between September 15, 2021 and March 15, 2022, with the possibility of extension for the right candidate.
